APPLY TO THE OVC FY 2023 TRIBAL VICTIM
SERVICES SET-ASIDE FORMULA GRANT
FROM THE DOJ/OFFICE FOR VICTIMS OF
CRIME TO FINANCE FAMILY AND
CHILDREN SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and By-Laws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians, the Tribe's governing body is the Delaware Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the DOJ/Office for Victims of Crime is accepting applications for the OVC FY 2023 Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Formula Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe of Indians desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing continuing funding to support the salary of a current domestic violence advocate, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council and Family & Children Services Department has identified domestic violence as a high priority need; and

WHEREAS, OVC FY 2023 Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Formula Grant will address domestic violence by providing wages to continue funding for a domestic violence advocate to provide supportive services to victims of domestic violence, and also allowing funding for a Kansas Domestic Violence Attorney to represent clients in court processes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, The Delaware Tribal Council of the Delaware Tribe of Indians does hereby authorize and approve the application submission for the OVC FY 2023 Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Formula Grant, the maximum funding amount of \$288,498, from the DOJ/Office for Victims of Crime and designates the Executive Director of Tribal Operations as the Authorizing Official to sign all documents relating to the OVC FY 2023 Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Formula Grant.
