UTILIZE ARPA FUNDS TO RENOVATE
TRIBAL HOUSING UNITS

RESOLUTION 2024-52

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribal Council is authorized by Article V of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians to represent and act in all matters that concern the general welfare of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and By-Laws of the Delaware Tribe of Indians, the Tribe's governing body is the Delaware Tribal Council and under Article V has the authority "to manage and control community tribal property, enterprises, and other economic projects and programs of the Delaware Tribe"; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe was allocated funding from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) from the U.S. Department of the Treasury established under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe holds its duty to utilize this funding for projects aimed at safeguarding and enhancing the overall well-being of Delaware tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Tribe has recognized the need for renovations on tribal housing units due to water damage, infrastructural issues, and other health and safety risks for occupants; and

WHEREAS, to offer safe and healthy housing to its members, the Delaware Tribe wishes to utilize ARPA-SLFRF funds in the amount of \$453,200 to renovate and improve housing units.


